Accounts and Descriptions

Adult Education—Contributions are used where the need is greatest within Adult Education and to assist with the administration of the EAGLE program. With limited state and federal funds available to deliver instruction to reach the more than 1.2 M Georgians without a high school diploma, additional funds are needed to reach more Georgians. The EAGLE Award recognizes and honors students who have demonstrated exceptional achievement in adult education classes.

Amy Holloway Scholarship (SkillsUSA)—Contributions benefit participants in the SkillsUSA program by providing financial support for tuition, fees, books, tools and supplies, or to cover expenses to attend the SkillsUSA National Conference. Amy inspired and touched many people throughout her life, but perhaps most important was her dedication to our students. She had a passion for their success, which was frequently showcased in the SkillsUSA Competitions she helped to coordinate.

Brenda Wise Scholarship—Contributions fund the payment of tuition, fees, and supplies for the EAGLE winner to continue his or her education at a TCSG college. Brenda Wise, a beloved member of the Technical College System of Georgia family, lost her courageous battle with cancer. Brenda was a tireless supporter of education and dedicated most of her career changing the lives of Georgia's students.

Certified Literate Communities Program (CLCP)—Contributions provide funds for the Georgia Press Association Award for Excellence in a CLCP, the Leaders of Distinction Awards, and the awards presented to CLCP directors for years of service annually. CLCPs are nonprofit collaborative partners whose purpose is to promote, support, and enhance literacy efforts within a specific community.

GED Fee Scholarship—Contributions benefit GED test takers with assistance by providing vouchers for GED testing. Sponsorship of one GED test taker for the four test series is only \$160, or a payroll contribution of less than \$7 per pay period.

Georgia Occupational Award of Leadership (GOAL) Program—Contributions cover costs associated with this event and provide recognition for students as well as leadership development. GOAL winners represent the “new image” of Georgia's technical colleges.

The Gretchen K. Corbin Last Mile Fund—Contributions provide TCSG students with “the last mile” of gap funding for tuition, fees, and books and help increase retention and graduation rates for all TCSG colleges.

Shirley Carver Miller Scholarship—Contributions provide funds to reward GED graduates by providing a financial incentive to work towards continuing their education at one of Georgia's technical colleges.

TCSG Employee Scholarship—Contributions provide scholarships to employees of the system office and their immediate family members to offset the cost of educational expenses, continuing education, and professional development.

TCSG General Scholarship—Contributions provide funds for assistance with the cost to attend college for students seeking a certificate, a diploma, or an associate's degree.

TCSG Public Relations Fund—Contributions provide funds to support educational, recognition, social, and cultural events and programs of the System; for hospitality extended to guests of the System; and attendance by members of the TCSG at receptions, dinners, and other events outside of the TCSG that are of significance to the System.

Veterans Initiatives—Contributions designated to provide support for military programs within TCSG.
